



LPO Annual Young Artists' Concerto Competition October 5, 2024

You could win a chance to play a concerto with the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra at one of its Young People's Concerts in January and February 2025! The LPO Young Artists' Concerto Competition will take place at Tulane University's Dixon Annex Recital Hall.

Participants will be required to perform one movement of a standard concerto or short piece for their instrument and orchestra. The selection should be no longer than ten minutes in duration and must be a piece that has orchestral accompaniment (no solo piano sonatas, for example). Contestants must also provide their own accompanists. The competition will be divided into two categories: Grades K-8 and grades 9-12. All previous contestants are strongly encouraged to participate (winners of previous year's competition are ineligible). A committee of musicians from the LPO will select the winners.

The LPO will not pay to rent orchestral accompaniments for concerto winners. If you are unsure whether your proposed concerto has orchestra parts available for sale, email library@lpomusic.com to inquire. If orchestral parts must be rented to perform your piece, you are responsible for paying that fee. Rental fees can range from \$100-\$400 or more depending on the piece and the number of performances.
